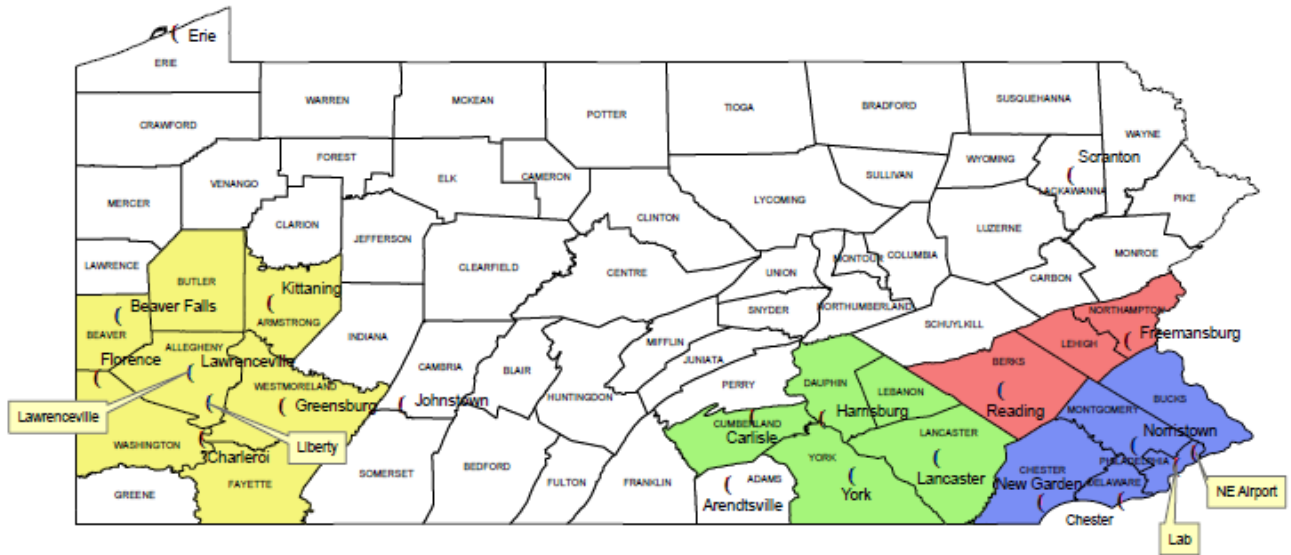


Pennsylvania PM 2.5 Monitor Map

 ■ Southwest (Pittsburgh Area)

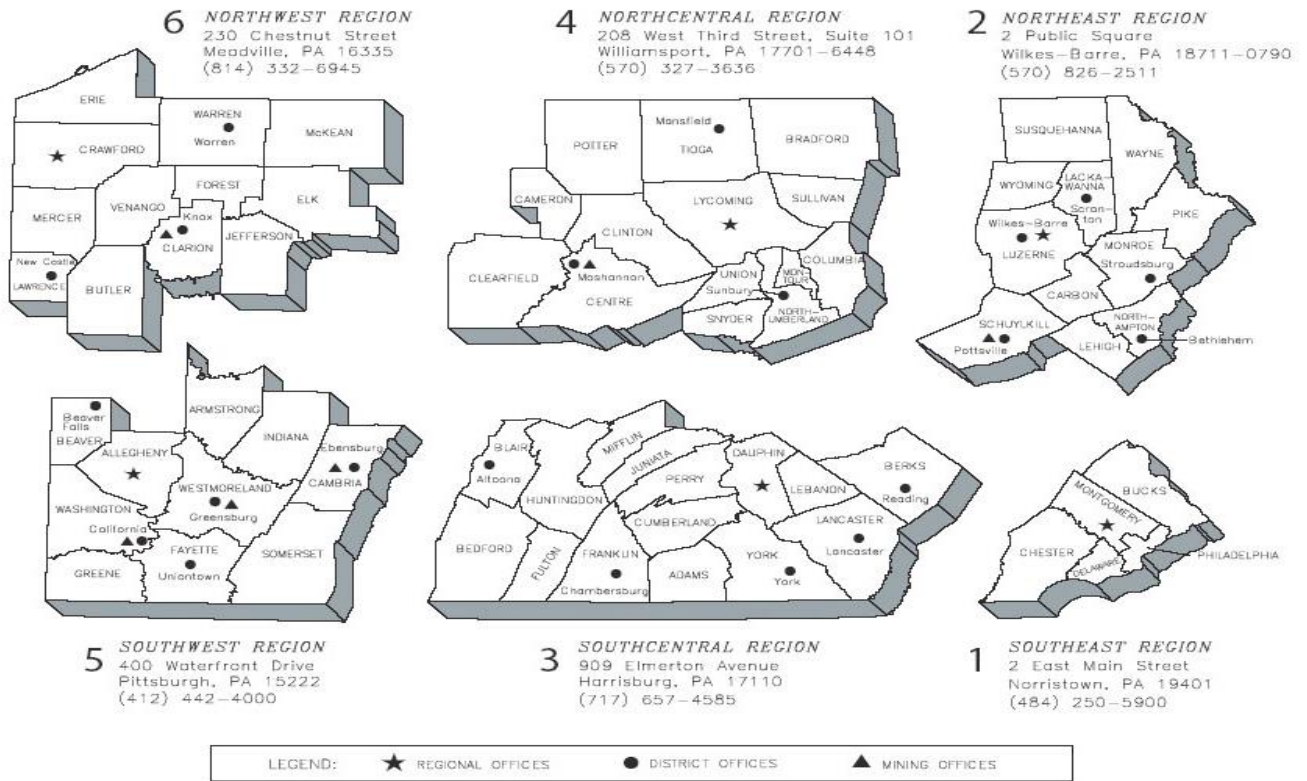
